National Water Quality Initiative

In partnership with the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), GCCD is conducting a Watershed assessment of five lower Crab Creek sub-watersheds in 2021.

The NRCS National Water Quality Initiative provides funding for planning and implementation of conservation practices that improve water quality.

Although the five lower watersheds encompass a small area of the Crab Creek Watershed, it is GCCD's intent to work with NRCS over the next several years to incorporate all remaining upper watershed areas into the NWQI program.

The lower Crab Creek NWQI study area includes diverse land uses including recreational, irrigated agriculture, rangeland, urban and light industrial uses. In completing this assessment, GCCD seeks input from as large and diverse groups as possible.
